

AEPC ENDORSEMENT OF CONSENSUS PAPERS/GUIDELINES

Published: 20 June 2021

APPLICATION PROCESS

An upfront request for endorsement is the preferred method to request AEPC endorsement. Herewith, the proposed AEPC members are able to participate from the very beginning to the writing of the consensus paper/guideline.

Application in 2 steps:

- AEPC endorsement can be applied for via the Educational Committee (EC):
 - 1. Sending the intention of the planned manuscript to the EC including a description of the topic, the aim of the paper, the organizing committee and the authors. The EC members will evaluate the planned consensus paper / manuscript taking into account the criteria mentioned below.
 - 2. Sending the final version of the manuscript for evaluation before publication.
- The approval by the EC will be presented to the AEPC Secretary General to acquire official endorsement from the AEPC Council.

CRITERIA FOR AEPC ENDORSEMENT

The consensus paper / manuscript is:

- Organized in participation with the AEPC or an AEPC Working Group (WG).
- Of high level teaching or summarizing the state of the art on the topic.
- Serving as an international guideline / recommendation on the topic.
- Having more than 2 authors which are AEPC members.

The AEPC has to be mentioned as a supporting organization on the paper which should be (co-)published in CITY.
