The Department of Paediatrics at the Leiden University Medical Center (LUMC) is recruiting for a sixth paediatric cardiologist. Paediatric Cardiology is one of the three main subspecialties of the department of Paediatrics. The LUMC is part of the Center for Congenital Heart Disease Amsterdam/Leiden (in Dutch CAHAL), a collaboration of three University Hospitals. The CAHAL is a high-volume congenital heart center with 3 congenital heart surgeons, 11 paediatric cardiologists, and 5 fellows paediatric cardiology. Neonatal congenital heart surgery is concentrated in the LUMC.

The candidate will be expected to participate in the catheterization laboratory and to perform diagnostic and interventional procedures. The candidate will also participate in clinical care, including care of postoperative patients, and general paediatric cardiology out-patient clinic.

Requirements

The selected candidate has completed three years of training in paediatric cardiology according to the guidelines of the AEPC.

Subspecialty training in interventional cardiology is preferred, as well as a track record of research experience.

Salary

A specific salary schedule, which is set out in the collective agreement for university hospitals, applies for the academic medical specialist and depends on your qualifications and experience.
