

Exclusion criteria

1. Any associated cardiac defect except persistent left superior vena cava and coarctation of the aorta
2. Any significant (i.e. that might influence outcome) extracardiac anomaly and/or known chromosomal aberration. Also, if such a condition is present at inclusion but diagnosed only after birth the case will be retrospectively excluded.

Endocardial fibroelastosis is accepted. Cases with severe mitral regurgitation and left atrial enlargement with or without restrictive or intact atrial communication and with or without hydrops will be included but analyzed as a separate group. Also cases with atrial septal balloon dilatation or stent placement will be included if the first intervention was aortic valvuloplasty or if no fetal aortic valvuloplasty was performed.
